- ✓ The capital of the Czech Republic (since 1993),
- ✓ The seat of the President, government and parliament and the political, cultural and economic centre of the country,
- ✓ Since 1992, the extensive historic centre of Prague has been included in the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites





## **PRAGUE – Basic information (2)**

**Population:** 1,250,000

Geographical location: 50° 05'19"N and 14° 25'17" E (city centre)
Height above sea level: 235 metres (average)
Area: 496 square kilometres
River: Vltava flows through Prague for 31 kilometres.

**Electricity supply:** 230 V

**Time:** CET - summer time (GMT +2)

## Currency – Czech crown (CZK)

Some suggestions:

- Better to change money in a bank or take cash out of ATM machines.
- Be careful when using money exchange offices. You may end up paying a high commission or getting a bad rate without even knowing about it.

*Coins:* CZK 1, 2, 5, 10, 20, 50 *Banknotes:* CZK 100, 200, 500, 1000, 2000, 5000

- 1 EUR 27,10 CZK
- 1 USD 24,20 CZK
- 1 GBP 30,10 CZK
