Increasing the Visibility of IEA Activities

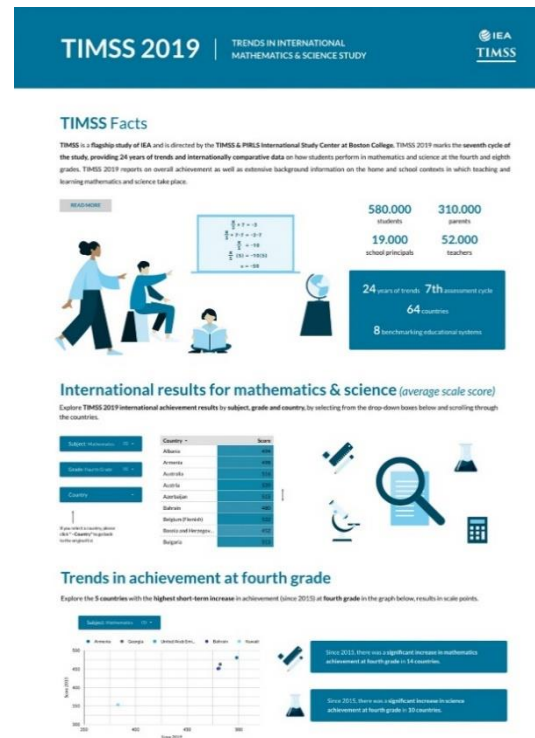
- IEA publications, communications channels, and events serve as important vehicles to highlight the work of IEA

Release of IEA TIMSS 2019

- +600 attended online release event
- From 80 countries
- +50 interviews with journalists
- +3,000 streams of event recording
- +3,600 TIMSS news articles in the week of the release
- +22,000 IEA website page views on day of release



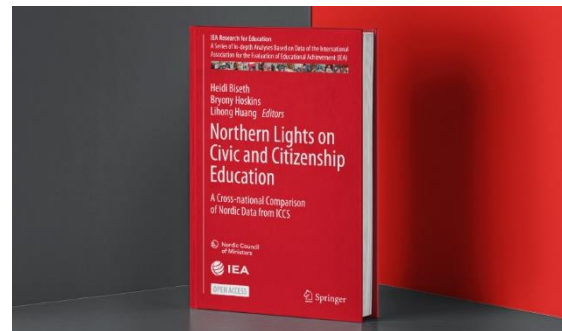
IEA Study Publications

- Continue to support the creation and dissemination of IEA international study publications and for studies in Germany
- TIMSS International Report 35.005 downloads to date



IEA Research for Education

- New releases from our *Research for Education* series
- New Springer series planned for 2022
- Total downloads (since February 2016 to October 2021): **697,825**
- Highest download for one title: **177,425**



Large-scale Assessments in Education Journal

- LSAE is indexed by ESCI and SCOPUS
- **144,160 downloads** in 2020 compared to 79,778 in 2019
- Highest number of downloads for one article: **34,000**

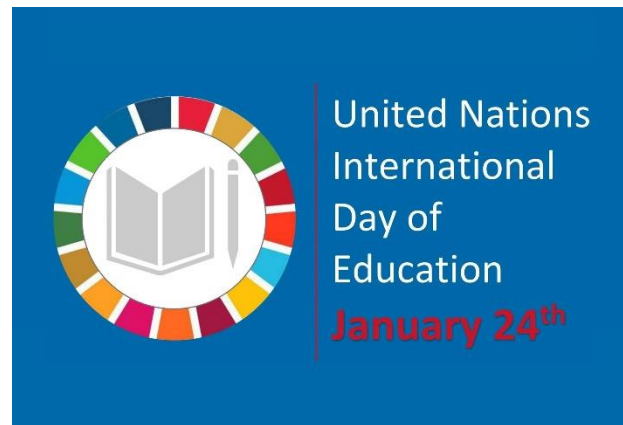
Upcoming events: Research Conferences
