

# POSTER PRIZE RAFFLE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## 1. General

- 1.1. These Terms and Conditions apply to the promotional game of chance, namely the Poster Prize Raffle ("Raffle") organized by the International Association for the Evaluation of Educational Achievement ("IEA"), established at Keizersgracht 311, 1016 EE Amsterdam, The Netherlands (hereinafter referred to as "IEA"). The Educational Research Centre of Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "ERC"), established at DCU St Patrick's College Campus, Drumcondra, D09 AN2F Dublin, Ireland, is the host of the IEA International Research Conference 2023 (hereinafter referred to as "IEA IRC"). IEA IRC is sponsored by [Fáilte Ireland](#), the National Tourism Development Authority of Ireland, in partnership with [Meet in Ireland](#).
- 1.2. The Raffle is offered in accordance with the Code of Conduct for Promotional Games of Chance (hereinafter referred to as "Code of Conduct") issued by the Dutch Gaming Authority (in force since 1 January 2014) and available [here](#).
- 1.3. IEA declares that it will act at all times in accordance with the provisions of the Code of Conduct.
- 1.4. In this context, Raffle has the same meaning as "promotional game of chance" as defined in Article 1 of the Code of Conduct, namely, it refers to giving the opportunity, by way of promotion, to compete for prizes or premiums, where the winners are designated by any determination of chance over which the participants generally cannot exercise a dominant influence.
- 1.5. Eligibility to participate in the Raffle includes all poster submissions between 1 September 2022 – 31 December 2022.
- 1.6. Participation in the Raffle signifies acceptance of these Poster Prize Raffle Terms and Conditions.

## 2. Participation

- 2.1. Participation in the Raffle is open to any natural person, with the exception of employees of IEA and/or employees of sponsors and/or partners of the IEA IRC.
- 2.2. Participants who are younger than 18 can only take part in the Promotion with the permission of at least one parent or legal guardian.
- 2.3. IEA may ask for proof of a participant's date of birth and/or for a copy of a valid form of identification.
- 2.4. A natural person may only participate in the Raffle one time. Participation using an intermediary is not allowed.
- 2.5. Coauthors are allowed to make one poster submission only. In cases where the winning poster is authored by two or more people, only the person who submitted the poster is entitled to the prize. In cases where the same poster is submitted two or more times, this poster will be automatically excluded from the Raffle.
- 2.6. Participation in the Raffle is free of charge. By submitting a poster that meets the poster submission guidelines, the Participant will automatically be entered into the Raffle for a chance to win one free registration (free entry), valued at 150 euros, to the 2023 IEA IRC in Dublin, Ireland.

2.7. Details about the Poster submission, as well as the requirements for such submission can be found [here](#) and are made available [in an Announcement] to the Participant before the submission of the Poster and before the Participant enters the Raffle.

2.8. IEA is entitled to exclude or refuse to award a prize (of free registration/free entry to the 2023 IEA IRC) to a participant in a Promotion if they are of the opinion that the participant is not acting in accordance with these Poster Prize Raffle Rules and Regulations, has provided incorrect, incomplete or misleading information, or is otherwise committing fraud.

### 3. Intellectual Property Rights

3.1. The submitted Poster must be an original work of the Participant, meaning that by submitting the Poster, the Participant declares that they are the owner of all intellectual property rights on the work and that they are not infringing on the rights of any third parties.

3.2. The Participant hereby grants permission to IEA, according to the Announcement, to use the work for promotional purposes or for other purposes, if they are stated in the Announcement. The participant will receive no compensation for the aforementioned use by IEA or, as the case may be, partners in question, but if such publication occurs, the Participant will be credited as the author of the work.

### 4. Prize

4.1. There will be only one winner. The selection of the winner will be done in an impartial manner, based entirely on chance. The winners will be designated by an independent third party or by an impartial computer program. There will be only one drawn on 12 January 2023, which will be recorded in order to abide by Article 4.6. of the Code of Conduct and demonstrate to the Dutch Gaming Authority how the winner is designated, provided this is requested.

4.2. The prize of one free registration (free entry valued at 150 euros) to the 2023 IEA IRC in Dublin, Ireland, is non-transferable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash or for another prize.

4.3. In case the 2023 IEA IRC is cancelled, for whatever reason, no claim may be made for any form of compensation.

4.4. The winner of the Raffle will be informed personally within three months after the end of the Poster submission deadline, via the e-mail address they have provided. If the winner does not respond within 14 days after notification, then they shall no longer be entitled to the prize.

4.5. Only the winner will be notified. The non-winning participants will not be notified.

4.6. The winner will be announced on IEA's website and/or other media, such as IEA's social media channels and online newsletters and those of any partners involved in the IRC.

4.7. The winner of the Raffle is required to register for the 2023 IEA IRC. The link to the registration can be found [here](#).

4.8. IEA will be responsible for paying the Tax on Games of Chance, if owed.

## 5. Data Protection

- 5.1. Any personal information made available by the Participant in the course of the Poster submission, including but not limited to their name, e-mail address will be kept confidential and processed in accordance with the General Data Protected Regulation. In particular, IEA handles personal data with care and takes technical and organizational measures to protect the participant's data against loss and against any form of unlawful processing. IEA will only use the data for organizational purposes, not for other purposes. The information that is requested is: name, organization/company, country, telephone number and e-mail address.
- 5.2. By participating in the Raffle, the Participant accepts that personal information will be recorded and used by IEA to carry out the Raffle, which also includes correspondence in the context of the Raffle and, if the Participant has consented via opt-in, sending the additional information mentioned in the opt-in.

## 6. Liability

- 6.1. IEA, their partners, and the third parties they have brought in are not liable for any damage, direct and/or indirect, that results from or is in any way connected with the Raffle, including but not limited to:
  - a) any additional expenses that the winner may incur in connection with the acceptance and use of the prize, including but not limited to travel and accommodation costs, as well as any booking or cancellation fees;
  - b) damage in relation to the prize they have been awarded or the use thereof;
  - c) the completeness and correctness of the information displayed or provided by Participant to IEA, for example an incorrect telephone number or email, which leads to an incorrect or unknown address of the participant ;
  - d) computer and/or internet outages and malfunctions in the network, hardware or software, which result in a restricted or delayed provision of data by the entrant, or loss of such data.
  - e) damage in connection with changes to or termination of the Raffle.
- 6.2. IEA makes no guarantees regarding the prize they will award.
- 6.3. Printing, spelling, typesetting or similar errors cannot be invoked against IEA and can in no way create an obligation for IEA.
- 6.4. IEA is not liable for any damage, of whatever nature, in connection with the use of the website or links to websites of third parties on its website or other technical facilities.

## 7. Miscellaneous

- 7.1. IEA is entitled, at their discretion, to change the Raffle and/or the Terms and Conditions during the Promotional period or to stop the Promotion without giving any reason. Changes to the Raffle and/or the Poster Raffle Terms and Conditions, as well as the termination of the Raffle, will be publicized by IEA on the appropriate website and communicated to the Participant by email.

7.2. Cases which are not covered in these Poster Raffle Terms and Conditions shall be decided by IEA.

7.3. Should one or more of the provisions in these Poster Raffle Terms and Conditions become invalid or unenforceable, IEA will determine a replacement provision that comes as close as possible to the purpose and purport of the invalid or unenforceable provision.

## 8. Complaints

8.1. Complaints regarding this promotion can be addressed to [secretariat@iea.nl](mailto:secretariat@iea.nl) within ten days after the complaint has arisen or could reasonably have been known about, under the subject "IRC Raffle complaint." The IEA will handle the complaint and contact the Participant about settling said complaint.

8.2. If the complaint is not settled to the satisfaction of the Participant, they have the option of submitting a complaint to the Dutch Gaming Authority with regard to promotional games of chance [PO Box 298, 2501 CG The Hague].

8.3. The Poster Raffle Terms and Conditions are governed exclusively by Dutch law. Any disputes arising from the Poster Raffle Rules and Regulations or the Raffle can only be brought before the competent court in Amsterdam.
